FROM THE PRINCIPAL

EARLY CLOSE FOR INTERVIEWS

Tomorrow the school closes at 11:15am for parentteacher interviews. The aim of this half day is to ensure that all parents have the opportunity to meet with their child's classroom teacher, either face-toface or over the phone to discuss academic progress, goals and any other matters relating classroom learning. This is incredibly valuable time for both parents and teachers and I encourage you to contact your child's teacher if you have not as yet booked a session time.

COVID MANAGEMENT

We have a few current cases of COVID-19 with some students and staff isolating at home. Almost all of these cases have returned positive results only after being in isolation as household close contacts, and therefore have not been at school while unknowingly infectious. Students (Years 3-6) and staff are still required to wear masks while indoors physical and ensure appropriate distancing measures are maintained as much as possible when outside.

Please contact the school if your child is in household close contact isolation, or has returned a positive RAT or PCR test.
