FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Term 2 Start

It has been a wonderful start to Term 2 and great to welcome our students and families back to school. As always our COVID guidelines are everevolving and we are very pleased that the easing of restrictions allows for us to return to a greater level of normality. We welcome back assemblies and community events, as well as parents in classrooms. While masks are not mandatory, individuals can always choose to wear them while at school as they wish to. Our focus on ensuring the school is clean and appropriately sanitised remains, and I thank parents for prompt communication with the school regarding positive test results.

NAPLAN

Next week our Year 3 and Year 5 students commence NAPLAN (National Assessment Program of Literacy and Numeracy) testing. Across two weeks students will each sit four tests focused on assessing core literacy and numeracy skills and understandings. The information provided through the outcomes of these assessments help us as a school judge how we are tracking in relation to schools of a similar context across Australia, and the areas that we need to focus on improving. Parents will receive their child's NAPLAN report in a few months, which identifies the achievement score for each test as well as where the student sits in relation to minimum benchmark and the national average. These assessments are not designed to cause any stress or worry to students; learning is a journey. In 2023, the NAPLAN testing will be moved to Term 1.

School Uniforms

Over the weekend we 'spoke too soon' and shared that the uniform shop had sufficient stock of winter items, and we apologise for the frustration this caused on Monday morning when this was largely not the case. Our uniform supplier has been

hampered by global shipping circumstances that have impacted productions, but are working hard to ensure continuity of supply. As a school that highly values full school uniform, your patience is greatly appreciated.

Aspire

As part of our Positive Behaviour Support approach at East Hamilton Hill PS, this term we are focusing on the expectation of 'Aspire' and what this means to our students. As a school we identify 'Aspire' as *making an effort, attempt, strive or try*, and we explicitly teach the importance of a positive attitude. Our PBS team are working on ways to share our CARE values with the community and planning for the return of events such as the CARE breakfast.

Concerns

We are incredibly fortunate to have such dedicated and passionate staff who hold the best interests of each and every student at the heart of all they do in order to ensure every student is successful in learning and life. Your child's teacher should be the first point-of-call for any learning or behaviour related concerns you have; however, my door is always open should you have any wider concerns that you wish to discuss. Our community is such an important part of who we are as a school and I value your voice and partnership.

Kindergarten 2023

Enrolments are now open for a limited number of places in kindergarten for 2023. If you have an eligible child due to start kindergarten next year I encourage you to complete an application at your earliest convenience. Kindergarten, while an essential element in early learning, is still considered non-compulsory schooling (until enrolled) and numbers are limited in every school. Parents are only permitted to complete an application for kindergarten at one school and we would not want any siblings of current students to miss out on a place.
