#### **RIDE SAFELY TO SCHOOL WEEK**

Next week is Ride Safely to School Week, and a perfect opportunity to remind students about safe practices when riding and scootering to school.

All students are required to wear a helmet when riding a bike, and follow safety guidelines including:

- $\checkmark$  Always ride with your hands on the handlebars.
- / Always stop and check for traffic in both directions when leaving your driveway, or a curb.
- Cross at intersections. When you pull out between parked cars, drivers can't see you coming.
- Walk your bike across busy intersections using the crosswalk and following traffic signals.
- Never ride against traffic.
- Use bike lanes wherever you can.
- Don't ride too close to parked cars. Doors can open suddenly.
- Stop at all stop signs and obey traffic (red) lights just as cars do.
- Ride single-file on the street with friends.
