



REPORTS

On Monday Semester 2 reports were emailed to parents via a link. This link is only active for a short period of time so parents will need to download and save a copy of each child's report in order to have access to it in the future. If you require a printed copy of your child's report please contact the office by Thursday morning.

Students who are achieving the required standard in a curriculum area for their year group are given a 'C' grade, in line with the School Curriculum and Standards Authority achievement standards for WA schools. Students demonstrating achievement above this receive 'B' or 'A' grades, and those not yet meeting the required standard will have a 'D' or 'E' grade. Each curriculum area has an ranking for the effort level demonstrated by your child throughout the semester and this is an excellent indicator of engagement, perseverance and learning dispositions. Recognising and celebrating your child's effort, regardless of the grade achieved, promotes a growth mindset that is beneficial to future learning endeavours.


