PARENT SURVEY

Tell Them From Me (TTFM) is a suite of surveys for measuring student engagement and wellbeing. The surveys capture student, parent and teacher voices, providing reliable evidence for schools to use in identifying strengths and areas for improvement. The TTFM Parent Survey helps to clarify and strengthen the important relationship between parents and our school. Insights into parent and staff communication, activities and practices at home, and parental opinions build an accurate and timely picture that can inform our planning. The survey is anonymous, voluntary, and easy-to-use. It is based on a comprehensive questionnaire covering several aspects of the parents' perceptions of their child's experiences at home and school. NAPLAN

Next week our Year 3 and Year 5 students NAPLAN (National Assessment commence Program of Literacy and Numeracy) testing. Across two weeks students will each sit four tests focused on assessing core literacy and numeracy skills and understandings. The information provided through the outcomes of these assessments help us as a school judge how we are tracking in relation to schools of a similar context across Australia, and the areas that we need to focus on improving. Parents will receive their child's NAPLAN report in a few months, which identifies the achievement score for each test as well as where the student sits in relation to minimum benchmark and the national average.

In 2023, the NAPLAN testing has been brought forward to Term 1, with the intention that earlier testing will result in schools being able to address gaps in student learning in a more timely manner. These assessments are not designed to cause any stress or worry to students; learning is a journey. Please speak to your child's classroom teacher should you have any questions or queries over the NAPLAN testing.



EARLY CLOSE FOR PARENT INTERVIEWS

On Thursday 30 March (Week 9) the school will be closing at 11:15am for parent-teacher interviews. The aim of this half day is to ensure that all parents have the opportunity to meet with their child's classroom teacher, either face-to-face or over the phone to discuss academic progress, goals and any other matters relating to classroom learning. A letter outlining the details of the day and booking options will come home shortly. The parent teacher meetings are an incredibly valuable time for both parents and teachers and I encourage all parents to book an appointment time with classroom teachers.


