OSHC

Earlier this month we received notification that our OSHC provider WANSLEA were unable to continue their before and after care service. Immediately following this confirmation, we commenced a process to secure a new provider. We are pleased to announce that TheirCare were successful in their application and we welcome them to our school in Term 2. Please find a welcome letter from TheirCare on the back page of the newsletter. WANSLEA will be ceasing operations on Friday, 28 April 2023. Due to licensing restraints, TheirCare are unable to start operating until Monday, 8 May 2023, at the earliest. This means that we will have one week (Week 2) where before and after school care is unavailable at our school. If this impacts your family and you are unable to arrange alternate care, please come and speak to me directly.

PRINCIPAL SELECTION

The Principal Selection Process has now been completed and we are currently awaiting confirmation of who the successful applicant is. It is expected that we will find out who the appointed person is during the school holidays. A Connect notice will be sent out to inform the community of the successful applicant.

ATTENDANCE CELEBRATION

Regular school attendance is vital to the education of our students. To ensure they have access to consistent, high quality teaching, it is essential they attend school every day unless they are unwell. Over the past two years we have been working tirelessly to increase our student attendance, to reach our Business Plan goal of 75% regular attendance. I am so proud to say that this term we have succeeded in our aspirations and have achieved 76.6% regular attendance, an increase of 25% from Term 4 2023!

We thank our families for their ongoing support in increasing our attendance. The gift of access to education is the greatest gift you can give your child! Students who have achieved over 90% regular attendance were acknowledged today with an icy pole treat and certificate. We look forward to seeing this positive trend continue for the benefit of our students and their opportunities to be successful in life.

If you or your child requires the schools support with attendance, please come and see me. The school will do all we can to support our students in attending school regularly.



BOOST PROGRAM

We have been fortunate enough to secure a grant through the Fogarty Foundation to host the DSF run **Boost** Program this year. The **Boost** program is designed to provide parents of children in Kindergarten to Year One with information and resources to best support their child’s early literacy development at home. Funding has been provided for 25-30 participants to attend the **Boost** workshop series, involving two half day workshops (9:00am - 12:00pm) running over two consecutive weeks, Thursday, 11 May and Thursday, 18 May. I strongly encourage all parents and caregivers to sign up to this program if they are available. Please see the team in the front office to enrol.

Our OSHC Team are ready to welcome your family to our OSHC service, to learn about your family's goals for OSHC and your child's unique interests. TheirCare aims to provide leisure based, social learning experiences for children in Outside School Hours Care through the dedication of our qualified educators so that we can support each child's spiritual, physical, social, intellectual, and emotional abilities.

Important updates for all families who will need to access OSHC:

- **Enrolment Information:** Enrolments will open on the 24/4/2023. Please stay tuned for more information to come regarding enrolments and bookings.
- **Families utilising the current provider:** Unfortunately, we are unable to directly transfer your bookings from your current OSHC provider. Please ensure you complete an enrolment and online bookings to secure your spot.
- **Our educators cant wait to make your child and family feel welcome and respected while using our service.** Our customer service team is available at all times to answer any questions you may have.
- **Our Before school care will open at 6:30am – bell times and will be \$24 per session before childcare subsidy.**
- **Our After school care will open at bell time – 6:00pm and will be \$34 per session before childcare subsidy.**

Over the coming weeks you will receive more information regarding TheirCare's Before School and After School Care Program at East Hamilton Hill Primary school.
