PARENT SURVEY

The "Tell Them From Me" survey is a suite of survey's capturing the thoughts and opinions of our students, parents and teachers. The survey gives us a great insight into areas of strength and improvement, which guides our school improvement agenda. This is the final year of a three year data collection cycle and information collected is analysed against results from the previous two years. Results are based on a comprehensive questionnaire covering several aspects of the parents' perceptions of their child's experiences at home and school. The survey is anonymous, voluntary, and easy-to-use and I ask that every parent take the opportunity to share their feedback with us. 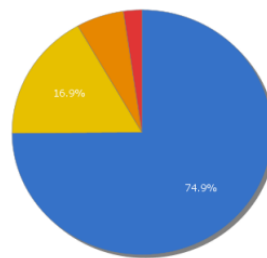
We encourage all parents to take a few minutes to share your opinions and thoughts with us as your voice is essential to the work we do. The survey closes Thursday, 28 March 2024.

NAPLAN

NAPLAN is finished for another year and our students conducted themselves wonderfully during the testing period. The results from this year's test will be available later in the year and as a school we will use this data to inform our planning and teaching. Thank you to Mr Beard for co-ordinating the NAPLAN testing program and to our teachers Mrs Elkins, Mrs Rowcliffe and Miss Simmons for supporting students through the test administration. Most importantly, well done to our students, we are so proud of you!

ATTENDANCE

We end Term 1 with a school attendance rate of 74.9% Regular attendance, just shy of our Business Plan goal of 75%. This is a vast improvement from last year and something our students should be very proud of. Regular school attendance is vital to the education of our students. To ensure they have access to consistent, high quality teaching, it is essential they attend school every day unless they are unwell.
