#### **PRINCIPAL POSITION 2025**

### **GATES AND CLASSROOM ACCESS 2025**

In response to increasing concerns regarding staff duty of care, we would like to inform the community of a change to the opening times of our school gates for 2025. The school gates will now open at 8:20am each morning, with classroom doors opening at 8:45am. For students arriving before 8:45am, they are welcome to sit on the bench outside the Breakfast Club, where our student leaders will provide toast and supervision will be available from 8:20am to 8:45am. Our OSHC provider, TheirCare, will continue to operate as normal in the mornings. If your child needs to be dropped off at school before 8:20am, they will need to be booked into TheirCare. We appreciate your understanding and support as we work to ensure the safety and well-being of all our students.

### **CANTEEN**

Following the departure of our dedicated Canteen Manager, Sharon Boreham, the P&C has decided to hand the running of the canteen back to the school. We would like to extend our sincere thanks to Sharon and the P&C for their hard work and for providing this important service to our community. For 2025, we are excited to announce that we are in negotiations with local businesses to provide the canteen service for us. The businesses will collaborate with Fresh SNAP to create a healthy and balanced menu for our students. 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#### **LANGUAGES**

Our Noongar Language teacher, Cassie Mippy will be taking leave in 2025 and will be an enormous loss to our school. As many people are aware, Miss Mippy has been instrumental immersing the Noongar culture language into our school community. She has worked tirelessly over the past 13 years in her roles as AEIO and Noongar Language Teacher to advocate for our students and families, creating an important connection between school and home. Cassie has been recognised for her leadership amongst the Aboriginal Languages Teachers in Western Australia and is currently the network co-ordinator for this group. We will miss Cassie's presence and passion next year and wish her well on her year of relaxation and wellbeing.

Following notification of Cassie's leave, we advertised the position in hopes of continuing our Noongar language program. Unfortunately, we were unable to fill the role. As LOTE Other Than English) (Languages Curriculum by the School requirement Standards Authority, the School Board has approved a shift in our language program to Auslan for 2025. We are fortunate to have three highly skilled Auslan translators already working within our school, and we believe that adopting Auslan as our language will further enhance and support the vital work they do. The position for an Auslan teacher is currently advertised, and we are excited to move forward with this new direction for our language program.

I would like to thank the P&C for their ongoing work this year, coming together for the betterment of our students. Thanks to Georgina Stoker and the committee for the hours they put into our school community. For the P&C to continue their great work, they require more support and numbers.
