FROM THE PRINCIPAL

NAPLAN

Our Year 3 and 5 students will start NAPLAN testing in Week 6. NAPLAN results allow parents/carers and educators to see how students are progressing in literacy and numeracy over time - individually, as part of their school community and against national standards. They provide schools, states and territories with information about how education approaches are working, areas to be prioritised for improvement and how individual schools can support teaching and learning of literacy and numeracy. Our focus as a school remains on students trying their best and completing all assessments to the best of their ability. Whilst students are well prepared for NAPLAN, we acknowledge that this is simply one test, on one day and can never be a full representative of our students' all-round abilities, strengths or talents.

SCHOOL BOARD

Our School Board plays an important role in contributing to good school governance so that school resources are used efficiently and community expectations and the school's priorities reflect the needs of students. The

EARLY CLOSE FOR PARENT INTERVIEWS

In Week 8 (Thursday, 27/03/25) the school will be closing at 11:15am for parent-teacher interviews. Providing time for teachers to meet with parents is crucial in addressing our reporting and assessment duties and school closures are a common practice across schools in Western Australia. By closing early, parents can meet with classroom teachers in the afternoon, either in face-to-face meetings or over the phone to discuss their child's progress and discuss any matters that may affect classroom learning. Parent teacher meetings are a valuable opportunity for parents and teachers to meet and I encourage all parents to book an appointment time with classroom teachers. A note with further information including how to book a meeting with teachers will be sent home soon. On the day, our after school providers. TheirCare will be open from 11:15am if you are unable to organise time off to collect/care for your children.

WE NEED A P&C RESIDENT!!


