FROM THE PRINCIPAL

It has been such a joy spending time in classrooms over the past few weeks, getting to know our students and seeing the learning that's taking place across the school. Whether it's working with Jordan in the gardens or presenting at assembly, our students continue to impress with their curiosity, kindness, and growing confidence.

BE ON TIME, EVERY TIME

A gentle reminder that classroom doors open at **8:30am** and all students should be at school by then. That early time is important, it allows students to settle, read, and get organised for the day. Arriving after the bell means missing instructions, which can affect learning and routine.

WASAP - WEST AUSTRALIAN STUDENT ASSISTANCE PAYMENT

A reminder that eligible families can still apply for WASAP. This government payment helps cover school-related costs. Our school's uptake has been lower than similar communities, so please don't hesitate to contact us if you'd like assistance with the process.

KAARTDIJIN LAUNCH

We've begun the phased roll-out of **Kaartdijin** - a new platform for recording attendance and behaviour. Kaartdijin (a Noongar word meaning *knowledge*) will help us build more consistent, data-informed systems that support student wellbeing. We're focusing on staff training first, information will be shared next week with families on how and when to access Kaartdijin for attendance.

KISS AND DRIVE REMINDER

For everyone's safety, please use the designated **Kiss and Drive** area for drop-offs and pick-ups. The staff car park is not a safe option, especially with angle parking and limited visibility, we've had a few close calls recently.

IN AND AROUND THE SCHOOL
