Last week, I had the pleasure of attending my first CARE Assembly. It was a joy to celebrate the values that make our school such a caring and inclusive environment. Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) underpins our approach to wellbeing and behaviour at East Hamilton Hill. Through our CARE values, Cooperate, Aspire, Respect, and Excel, we are building a school culture where students are supported to make good choices, grow as individuals, and feel connected to their learning and their peers.

Looking ahead, swimming lessons will take place in Term 3, Weeks 3 and 4. The total cost is \$60 per student, which covers bus transport and pool entry. While the program itself is funded, families are required to cover this fee. We understand that this can be a significant cost, and ask that payment be made in full as soon as possible. Unfortunately, we will not be in a position to take students whose fees have not been paid. Learning to swim is an essential life skill, especially given our proximity to the coast. We strongly encourage all families to prioritise swimming lessons.

Finally, as we approach the end of term, I encourage everyone to take the upcoming school holidays as a time to pause and reconnect. Enjoy the slower pace, read together, play, and cherish time with loved ones. Stay warm, stay safe, and we look forward to welcoming everyone back on Monday, 21 July for another exciting term of learning.
