CRICKET NETS – GRANT SUCCESS

Exciting news! East Hamilton Hill Primary School has been successful in receiving a CUSFF grant of \$10,842. This funding will support the upgrade and repair of our cricket pitches, including the installation of synthetic turf. These improvements will benefit both our students and the Hilton Junior Park Cricket Club.
